Emergency Procedures and Incident Control

- This hotel has an Emergency Procedures Manual, which covers a wide variety of crisis situations. These procedures cover items such as fires and evacuations, chemical spills, medical emergencies, food contamination, bomb threats, etc.
- The hotel's Executive Committee reviews these procedures semi-annually

Emergency Power

- This hotel has an emergency generator for designated lighting and power to key systems and equipment.

Property Security

- Uniformed Security staff on property 24/7
- Security cameras are provided in certain public areas as a deterrent to crime:
 - 70+ cameras
 - Footage retained for a minimum of 30 days
- Enhanced after-hours security measures:
 - Restricted entry points
 - Interior and exterior security patrols
- Sign-in and identification procedures are in place for visiting contractors.
- Dial "0" to reach Security 24/7

Guest Room Security

- Electronic locks with interrogation capability
- Secondary locking devices on entry, balcony and connecting doors
- Entry door viewers
- Self-closing entry doors

Fire Protection

- This hotel complies with the requirements of local fire safety enforcement laws.
- The fire system includes automatic detection, audible alarms, public address and 24/7 monitoring.
 - Smoke detectors present in public areas and guest rooms
 - Sprinkler systems in public areas and guest rooms
 - Monitoring services by Convergent Technologies
- Fire drills are conducted semi-annually involving all team members
- Team members trained in fire evacuation procedures are on duty 24/7
- Fire system and firefighting equipment internal inspections are conducted at regular intervals.
- Fire system and firefighting equipment are professionally inspected semi-annually.
- Fire evacuation routes are posted on the interior of each guest room door.
- Manual fire alarm pull stations are available throughout the hotel.
- Fire assembly areas are the southwest and northeast corners of the parking lot.

Safety and Security Features

First Aid/CPR and Medical Emergencies

- Personnel certified in First Aid and CPR are on duty 24/7.

Human Resources

- Drug-free workplace policy is in place.
- Workplace violence policy and related training is in place.

Workplace Safety

- All team members are provided safety and security training at hire and annually thereafter.
- OSHA and state regulatory compliance programs and related training are in place.
- Team members are encouraged to raise safety concerns or suggestions for improvements with the department's manager or safety committee representative.
- Accidents which cause or have the potential to cause injury or damage are reported to management and investigated thoroughly.
- The supply and use of chemicals or hazardous substances in the hotel is controlled, as is the provision of personal protective equipment.
- The hotel has specific foodborne illness response procedures.
