Dear Mr. Klemm:

This confirms our understanding and agreement with respect to job protections and the contracting out of work. United hereby commits that, through December 31, 2026, the Company will not contract out any non-core work to outside vendors currently performed by those IAM-represented United employees covered under the Fleet Service Employees, Passenger Service Employees, Central Load Planner Employees, Storekeeper Employees, Maintenance Instructor Employees, Fleet Technical Instructors & Related Employees and Security Officer Employees collective bargaining agreements, with the exception of non-core work including:

- Administrative duties, business office work and scheduling
- Business Partner Program (BPP) in Cargo Reservations
- Web Master duties
- Aircraft Lavatory and Water Service
- Aircraft Cabin Cleaning
- Breaking Aircraft Food Service Seals
- Baggage Claim Bag Shagging

After December 31, 2026 the provisions of Article 2 in the collective bargaining agreements for IAM-represented employees will remain in full force and effect, except to the extent modified by subsequent agreement.
