This summarizes our discussion regarding United's commitments regarding in-sourcing of certain work at designated airport locations.

United has agreed that, contingent upon IAM membership ratification and the Union's execution, no later than May 1, 2023, of the tentative agreements covering Fleet Service Employees and Passenger Service Employees dated May 1, 2023, the specified ramp operations and customer service functions at Miami, FL (MIA) and Colorado Springs, CO (COS) and the ramp operations currently performed in support of United Airlines/United Express operations under contract by outside vendors at Atlanta, GA (ATL), Raleigh Durham, NC (RDU), and Salt Lake City, UT (SLC) will, within 180 days of ratification (as long as sufficient Ground Service equipment is available, but in no case more than 12 months from DOR), be in-sourced and performed by United Fleet Service and/or Passenger Service employees. and will be subject to the provisions of Article 2.A.1 of the respective agreements.

Open positions, as determined by the Company, within the job classifications in the Fleet Service and/or Passenger Service workgroups, as applicable, at the above locations will be filled in accordance with the provisions governing recall and filling of vacancies under the respective agreements.
